Board of County Commissioners, met pursuant to adjournment at the office of the County Clerk.

There were present Commissioners J. E. Walton, Chairman, John Walton and P. A. Colbee, and County Clerk H. O. Stevens.

The Board having under consideration the aforesaid Road and no legal objections having been offered against the establishment of the same and believing it to be of public utility, It was ordered, That the Viewers report and view and report and plat of survey be adopted and the said road be declared located and established in accordance therewith full record thereof to be made in the County Road Record and the Trustee of Eudora Township be notified to cause the same to be opened for the public use. It was further ordered That the County Clerk be instructed to draw county scrip in favor of John Gilman for \$35.00, C. P. Perkins for \$95.00 in full compensation for all damages occasioned by the location and establishment of said road,
