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In the matter of the Petition of
Wm Roe and others for the Location
of a Road.

{ On the 16th day of December 1882, a Road
petition was filed signed by Wm Roe and 12 others and presented to the
Board of Comrs. praying for the location of a Road described as follows:
Beginning at the N.W. cor. Sec. 24, T. 14 S. to S.W. cor. of Sec. 24, T. 14 S. R. 20.
Said petition was accompanied with Bond as required by law signed by
Wm Roe as principal in the sum of costs and expenses, which bond
was approved, and it appearing to the Board that the law had
been substantially complied with It was ordered That G. W. Fitz, J. R. Johnson,
and Isaac Humphreys be appointed Viewers of the said road and that
upon the day named in their notice together with the County Surveyor
they proceed to view and lay out said road according to law, giving
to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings
to this Board.
