Purchase of Bonds {

{ It was ordered by the Board that the County Treasurer be authorized to purchase ten one thousand dollar Douglas County Refunding Bonds bearing date of December 31st 1879, the same to be paid for from the County sinking fund.

Proposition of W. T. Sinclair {

{ The Board having under consideration the aforesaid proposition It was ordered that the County Treasurer be authorized to transfer to W. T. Sinclair Ex. Sale lots No. 907, sale of 1877, and Cert 557, sale of 1881, being on S. 14.4 ft. of S. E. 1/4 of N. 1/2 Block 2, North Lawrence for \$50.00 without cost of transfer.

Proposition of Mark Freeman {

{ The Board having under consideration the aforesaid proposition It was ordered that the County Treasurer be authorized to permit Mark Freeman to redeem Lot 13, Vermont Street Lawrence from sales 1868, 1875, 1879, for amount of original sales without interest or cost of redemption.

Proposition of Geo Gardner, {

{ The Board having under consideration the aforesaid proposition It was ordered that Geo Gardner be permitted to redeem from sale at ten per cent interest on the Tax sale of 1863, of S. 1/2 of S. E. 1/4 of Sec 31, T. 12, R. 20, the following; commencing at a point in the center of Delaware St. Eads Add. Lawrence, where center of Lee St. intersects with said Delaware St. thence E. along center of Lee St. 330. ft. to a stake, S. parallel with Delaware St. 675. ft. to center of Adams St. N. along center of Adams St. 330. ft. to center of Delaware St. to beginning, containing 5⁷⁵/₁₀₀ acres, being N. 1/2 of Block 7, Eads Add. City of Lawrence.
