Now therefore, for the purpose of compromising and settling said claim, this Board agrees to accept the sum of Two Hundred Dollars in full payment and settlement and satisfaction of said claim and which sum the said McCoy hereby agrees to pay and the receipt of the same is hereby acknowledged.
