Solomon McCurdy. { The Board having under consideration the aforesaid proposition It was ordered that Solomon McCurdy be permitted to redeem from sale to County in 1868, with endorsement Lot 55, Vermont St. Lawrence, for \$50⁰⁰ and the surrender of all outstanding tax Certs on the same.

James McCurdy. { The Board having under consideration the aforesaid proposition It was ordered That the County Treasurer be authorized to transfer to James McCurdy the County's interest in Lot 55 Tennessee St. Lawrence for \$30⁰⁰ and Lot 57, Tennessee St. Lawrence for \$40⁰⁰ without cost of transfer.
