Green and others for the vacation of certain streets and alleys in Prairie City, it was ordered that the said vacation be made as follows: All streets and alleys between Robinson and Fremont Sts. except that part of Sumner St. bet R.R. and School House, except that part of Main St. between Public road and said excepted part of Sumner St. except that part of Robinson St. between Main and Aurora Sts. Also all streets and alleys between Liberty and Republican Sts. except that part of Liberty Street lying north from Public road to Catholic Church except that part of Aurora St. lying N. of R.R. bet R.R. and N. line of said town, lying in Prairie City.
