

In the matter of the petition
of E. M. Snyder et al for the
vacation of a road.

On the 2^d day of June 1883, a road petition was filed and presented to the Board of Commissioners, signed by E. M. Snyder and 18 others praying for the vacation of a road described as follows: That portion of the furber Road between Sec's 7 and 8, T. 14, R. 18, that is now located off the Sec. line between said Secs. and to relocate the same on the Sec. line between Sec's 7 and 8, T. 14, R. 18. Said petition was accompanied with bond as required by law signed by E. M. Snyder as principal and J. Rahskopf as surety in the sum of costs and expenses which bond was approved and it appearing to the Board that the law had been substantially complied with it was ordered That M. W. Nutscher, Henry Hoover and Wesley Pless be appointed as viewers of the said road and that upon the day named in their notice, together with the County Surveyor they proceed to view and lay out said road according to law giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to this Board.

In the matter of the petition
of Eben Baldwin et al for the
vacation and Location of a Road.

On the 10th day of April 1883, a road petition was filed signed by Eben Baldwin and 20 others and presented to the Board of County Commissioners praying for the vacation of the Road described as follows: Locals, Begin at NE cor. of E & W Sec. 13, T. 12, R. 19, thence N. 74th 00' 00" E. 70' W. 9 chs. to intersect County road No. 64.

Vacate. That part of Road No. 64 that commences at a stone in N. bank of Mud Creek 13th chs N. of center of Sec. 13, T. 12, R. 19, thence N. 66° 45' W. 2 chs N. 55° 30' W. 16 chs to stone in S. bank of Lake, N. 17° 30' W. to intersect road asked for in this petition. Said petition was accompanied with bond as required by law signed by Eben Baldwin as principal which bond was approved and it appearing to the Board that the law had been substantially complied with it was ordered That Wm. Brown & A. Wacker and George Wilson be appointed Viewers of the said road and that upon the day named in their notice together with the County Surveyor they proceed to view and lay out said road according to law, giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to this Board.
