

In the matter of the Petition of
James Tully et al for the
Location of a Road.

{ On the 13th day of March 1883, a road petition was filed signed by James Tully and 22 others and presented to the Board of Commissioners praying for the location of a road described as follows, commencing at the S.W. cor. of Sec. 26, T14, R.18, thence on a line North to intersect a Road running E and W. at a point in the N.E. 1/4 of Sec. 22 T. 14, R.18. length of road 2. miles. Said petition was accompanied with bond as required by law, signed by James Tully as principal and W. Massena and David Tully as sureties in the sum of bonds and expenses which bond was approved and it appearing to the Board that the law had been substantially complied with It was ordered That J. A. McAdams, J. W. Donald and J. B. Barber be appointed viewers of the said road and that on the day named in their notice together with the County Surveyor they proceed to view and lay out said road according to law giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to the Board.

In the matter of the Petition of
A. S. Baldwin et al for the
Location & vacation of a Road.

{ On the 7th day of April 1883, a road petition was filed signed by A. S. Baldwin and 26 others and presented to the Board of Commissioners praying for the vacation and relocation of a road as follows:
Vacate That portion of the Lawrence & Emporia State Road now located through the N.E. 1/4 of Sec. 28, T13, R.18. Relocate beginning on the 1/2 Sec. line on the N of Sec. 28, T13, R.18. and running thence E. in or near Sec line between Secs 21 & 28 T13, R.18. about 1000 ft. to intersect with Lawrence & Emporia State Road. Said petition was accompanied with bond signed by A. S. Baldwin as principal and E. S. Macy and H. Brown as sureties in the sum of One Hundred dollars, which bond was approved and it appearing to the Board that the law had been complied with It was ordered That A. E. Platt, S. W. McIsaac & J. C. Cotton be appointed viewers of the said road and that upon the day named in their notice together with the County Surveyor they proceed to view and lay out said road according to law giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to the Board.
