

In the matter of the petition of {  
Jacob Mauley and others for the  
location of a Road.

{ On the 9<sup>th</sup> day of April 1883, a road petition was  
filed signed by Jacob Mauley and 46 others and presented to the Board  
of Comrs. praying for the location of a road described as follows:  
Begin at the terminus of the road running N. from Willow Springs P.O. to  
S.E. corner of N.E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. 9 T14, R19, thence N. 160. R to S.E. cor of Sec. 4, T14, R19, N.  
W. R. to S.W. cor of S.E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. 4 T14, R19, N. 1 mile in  $\frac{1}{2}$  sec line to N.W.  
cor of N.E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. 4, T14, R19, to intersect public road, said petition was  
accompanied with bond as required by law signed by Jacob  
Mauley as principal and A. Brohman as surety in the sum  
of One Hundred Dollars, which bond was approved and it  
appearing to the Board that the law had been substantially  
complied with it was ordered that D.C. Halbert Thos Bond and  
J.O. Nelson be appointed Viewers of the said road and that  
upon the day named in their notice together with the County  
Surveyor they proceed to view and lay out said road according  
to law giving to all parties a hearing and make due report  
of their proceedings to this Board.

In the matter of the Petition of {  
O. McCallan and others for  
the vacation and relocation  
of a Road.

{ On the 4<sup>th</sup> day of April 1883, a road petition was  
filed and presented to the Board of Comrs. signed by O. McCallan and 17 others  
praying for the vacation and relocation of a road described as follows:  
Commence vacating 40 ft N. of S.W. cor. of N.W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of S.E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. 36, T11, R17, thence N. to  
N.W. cor. of N.W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of S.E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. 36, T11, R17, Commence relocating as the N.W. cor. of N.W.  $\frac{1}{4}$   
Sec. 1, T12, R17, thence N. 30. R. on sec line, thence Northw. to intersect road leading  
from Glendale to County line or or opposite mile post 36, on AT&ST RR. Said petition  
was accompanied with Bond as required by law signed by O. McCallan  
as principal and A.W. Mitchell as surety in the sum of One Hundred Dollars  
which bond was approved and it appearing to the Board that the law  
had been substantially complied with it was ordered that J. Cunningham  
J. McConda and Thomas Emery be appointed Viewers of the said road and  
that upon the day named in their notice together with the County Surveyor  
they proceed to view and lay out said road according to law  
giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their  
proceedings to this Board.

Board adjourned to meet April 11<sup>th</sup> 1883, at 9 o'clock A.M.
