Board of County Commissioners pursuant to adjournment at the office of the County Clerk.

There were present Commissioners J. E. Walton, Clerk; John Walton and P. A. Holter and County Clerk N. O. Stevens.

J. E. Deering Trustee of Marion Township and E. E. Gaddis Trustee of Palmyra Township made report of the business of their several Townships for the past year which reports were approved.

In the matter of the Petition of
H. H. Kestel for the Location of
a Road.

The Board having under consideration the aforesaid road and no legal objection having been offered against the establishment of the same and believing it to be of public utility, It was ordered that the Viewers report and View and report and plat of survey be adopted and the said road be declared located and established in accordance therewith full record thereof to be made in the County Road Record and the Trustee of Palmyra Township be notified to cause the same to be opened for the public use. It was ordered that the County Clerk be instructed to issue County scrip in favor of Wilbur Moses for \$25⁰⁰ in full compensation for all damages occasioned by the location and establishment of said road.

Dedication of a
Road to McCannan

The Board having under consideration the dedication of a Road by S. H. & L. J. McCannan It was ordered that said dedication be accepted as follows: Begin at E. end of Massachusetts St. Lawrence at S. line of said City of Lawrence Thence S 30 R. to E. line of Sec. 6, T. 13, R. 20. It was further ordered that the Clerk be instructed to issue County scrip in favor of McCannan for \$200⁰⁰ in full compensation for all damages occasioned by the location and establishment of said road.
