Board of County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment at the office of the County Clerk.

Those were present Leming, W. A. Acton, Chew, John Weston and P. A. Bolton and County Clerk H. J. Thomas.

Appropriation to pay judgments. { The Board ordered that an appropriation of \$1600⁰⁰ be made from the County Quindary fund to pay certain judgments against Douglas County, rendered in District Court in and for said County, in favor of Keulin, Wilson & Ward. Also, an appropriation of \$75⁰⁰ to complete a County Bridge in Palmyra Township.

Proposition of J. S. Fletcher { The Board having under consideration the aforesaid proposition It was ordered that the County Treasurer be authorized to transfer to J. S. Fletcher trustee, the tax cuts for sale of 1861 on Lots 5 and 6, Block 74, Palmyra City for amount of sale without interest or cost.

Review of Atchison & Lawrence St Road { The Board having under consideration the petition of Samuel Bergan and others. It was ordered that Ed Zimmerman, J. L. Gilmors and J. C. Wilson be appointed viewers to view and determine as to the Location of the Atchison & Lawrence State Road, and make due report of their proceedings to this Board.

Dedication of Road by C. Sawyer et al {

The Board having under consideration the proposition of Henry Sawyer and others which proposition for dedication was filed April 11th 1883. It was ordered that the Road so dedicated be accepted and granted in accordance with the filed notes of the Surveyor.
