

Laurie, Kansas, July 3rd 1883.

Board of County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment at the office of the County Clerk.

There were present Lewis J. Walton, Chairman, John Walton and O. A. Dolbe and County Clerk M. O. Johnson.

Proposition of J. S. Fletcher. { The Board having under consideration the aforesaid proposition it was ordered That the County Treasurer be authorized to transfer to J. S. Fletcher the County interest by reason of tax sales in Lots 47, 49, 51 and 53, Indiana Street. Baldwin lot for \$3⁷⁵ per lot. without cost of transfer.

In the matter of the Petition of Eben Baldwin and others for the location of a Road { The Board having under consideration the aforesaid Road and no legal objections having been offered against the establishment of the same and believing it to be of public utility It was ordered That the Viewers report and View and report and plat of survey be adopted and the said road be declared located and established in accordance therewith full record thereof to be made in the County Road Record and the Trustee of Wakarusa Township be notified to cause the same to be vacated and opened.

In the matter of the Petition of John Watts et al for the location of a Road. { On the 21st day of June A.D. 1883, a road petition was filed signed by John Watts and 19 others and presented to the Board of Commissioners praying for the location of a road described as follows. Commencing at N.W. corner of Sec 22 Township 13 Range 18 Thence E on County line between Franklin and Douglas Co to intersect the County Road dividing said County's in Sec 23, T. 13, R. 19 E. Road to be 40 ft wide. Length 7 miles. Said petition was accompanied with bond as required by law signed by Jos Barnhart and W. S. Ward in the sum of One Hundred Dollars. which bond was approved and it appearing to the Board that the law had been substantially complied with It was ordered that F. W. Keastman, Moses McMillan and Silas Gavin be appointed Viewers of the said Road and that upon the day named in their notice together with the County Surveyor they proceed to View and locate said Road according to law giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to this Board.
