

In the matter of the Petition of
J. H. Dick and others for the
Location of a Road.

{ On the 4th day of June AD 1883, a Road petition was filed signed by J. H. Dick and 11 others and presented to the Board of Co. Comm. praying for the location of a Road described as follows: Beginning at that point in Grant Township where the Range line between Ranges 19 and 20 crosses the County line between the Counties of Douglas and Jefferson thence running E. on said County line to the corner of Section 6, and 5 in Douglas Co and Secs 31 and 32 in the County of Jefferson. Said petition was accompanied with bond as required by law signed by J. H. Dick as principal and McRoss as surety in the sum of costs and expenses which bond was approved and it appearing to the Board that the law had been substantially complied with It was ordered that Jefferson Wilson, Charles Lott, and J. H. Tyson be appointed Viewers of the said Road and that upon the day named in their notice together with the County Surveyor, they proceed to view and lay out said road according to law, giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to this Board.

In the matter of the Proposition of
J. E. Riggs.

{ The Board having under consideration the proposition of J. E. Riggs It was ordered That the County Treasurer be authorized to transfer to J. E. Riggs the County's interest by reason of tax sales in E 1/2 of Lot 18, Vermont St Laramie, Kan including cty 25 Dec 1857 being for 1/2 of said Lot, and cty 2 Dec 1868, being for 1/2 of said Lot for \$15.00 without cost of transfer.
