E. D. F. Phillips and others for the

Location of a Road. { On the 3d day of July AD 1883, a Road petition was filed signed by E. D. F. Phillips and 22 others, praying for the Location of a Road described as follows: Beginning at a point where the Sec line between Secs 28 and 29, crosses a line running East and W. through the center of said Secs in T12, R20, and running E through the center of said Sec. 28, to E. line of Douglas Co. Said petition was accompanied with bond as required by law signed by Charles Oliver as principal and A. J. Dickey and J. Tyson as sureties in the sum of costs and expenses which bond was approved and it appearing to the Board that the law had been substantially complied with It was ordered That Wm. Turner, Eli Wilson and A. E. Onew be appointed Viewers of the said Road and that upon the day named in their notice, together with the County Surveyor they proceed to view and lay out said road according to law giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to this Board.
