

Lawrence, Kansas. July 7th 1883.

Board met pursuant to adjournment at the office of the County Clerk.

There were present Commissioners J. C. Walton Chairman, John Walton and P. A. Dolbee and County Clerk M. J. Stevens.

In the matter of the Petition of P. A. Heastig and others for the Vacation of certain Streets and Alleys in Endersa City.

On the 5th day of July 1883, a petition was filed signed by P. A. Heastig and 37 others and on this day presented to the Board of Co. Commrs. Said petition was praying for the Vacation of streets and alleys in the City of Endersa as follows, to wit: First Street between I and K. Streets, second Street between I and J Streets, and third Street between F and G Streets, D and E. Streets between the Wakarusa River and the Kansas River, also F. G. and H. Streets between Third Street and the Kansas River, also alleys in Blocks 102, 103, 104, 105, 106, 107, 140, 141, 142, 174, 175, 176, 177, and 310. The Board having the same under consideration and believing it to be for the best interests of the public It was ordered that the petition be granted as prayed for and that the Vacation be ordered in accordance therewith.

The Board had under consideration accounts against the County.

Board adjourned to meet July 9th 1883. at 9 o'clock a.m.
