Board of Co. Commis met pursuant to adjournment at the office of the County Clerk.

There were present Comis J. C. Walton Chairman. John Walton and P. A. Dotter and County Clerk W. J. Turner.

In the matter of the Petition
of C. W. Thompson et al for the
Location of a road.

On the 7th day of July 1883. a road petition was filed signed by C. W. Thompson and 23 others and presented to the Board of County Commis praying for the location of a road described as follows: Beginning at the South West corner of the N. W. 1/4 of Sec 23, T. 15, R. 17. on the County line thence N. on County line 2 1/2 miles to highway running to Topeka. Said petition was accompanied with bond as required by law signed by C. W. Thompson as principal and Anton Reesche as surety in the sum of costs and expenses and it appearing to the Board that the law had been substantially complied with it was ordered That Thomas Seerist, Thomas Pierson and Samuel Buckhriem be appointed Viewers of the said Road and that upon the day named in their notice together with the County Surveyor they proceed to view and lay out said road according to law giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to this Board.
