The Board having under consideration the aforesaid Road and no legal objections having been offered against the establishment of the same and believing it to be of public utility It was ordered That the Views report and view and report and plat of survey be adopted and the said road be declared vacated and relocated in accordance therewith full record thereof to be made in the County Road Record and the Trustee of Leecompton Township be notified to cause that part vacated to be closed and that part Located to be opened for the public travel.

Appropriation to pay
County costs in U.S. Cases
in Bond Cases.

The following resolution was presented to the Board and on motion adopted: Resolved That an appropriation of \$133 ⁵⁵/₁₀₀ be made from the County Sinking Fund to pay Clerk's fees in U.S. Circuit Court in Bond Cases. It was ordered That the Chairman of the Board and Clerk be authorized to draw on the Co. Treasury for the amount of said appropriation.
