Annual Levy of Taxes

The Board having under consideration the matter of levying taxes for the year AD 1883. It was ordered that the following Levy be made on all the taxable property in the County of Douglas:

For Road purposes 3 mills on the dollar. State, City and School Dist taxes as recommended and certified according to law.
