Welch to redeem from tax sales to County Lots 151, 159, 142, 144, 145, 153, Pennsylvania St Lawrence for amount of sales without cost of Redemption, also to permit H. M. Welch to redeem Lot 155, N. J. St on same terms as just above, also to transfer to John E. McCurdy the County interest in Lot 146 corner St for amount of sales without interest or cost of transfer.
