

In the matter of the Petition of  
J.S. Masterson & others for the  
location of a road.

On the 1<sup>st</sup> day of October 1883, a road petition was filed and presented to the Board of Co. Comrs signed by J.S. Masterson and 23 others praying for the location of a County Road described as follows: Beginning at a point on the Laumne and Sopella road at the N.W. cor. of 28 $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec 5, T.12.R.18, thence N. on  $\frac{1}{2}$  sec line to center of Sec. 32, as shown by a small drawing. Said petition was accompanied with Bond as required by law signed by J.S. Masterson as principal and Jas A. Davidson as surety in the sum of all costs and expenses which bond was approved and it appearing to the Board that the law had been substantially complied with. It was ordered that J.F. Jones, Ebenezer Baldwin & Asa Richardson be appointed Viewers of the said road and that upon the day named in their notice together with the County Surveyor they proceed to view and lay out said road according to law giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to this Board.

Moses McMillan and others for  
the location of a road.

On the 1<sup>st</sup> day of October 1883, a road petition was filed and presented to the Board of Co. Comrs signed by Moses McMillan and 13 others praying for the location of a County Road described as follows: Begin at S.W. cor. of 5.8 $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec 11, T. 15, R. 18, thence E. on sec line as near as practicable 1 $\frac{1}{2}$  miles. Said petition was accompanied with Bond as required by law signed by M. McMillan in the sum of all costs and expenses which bond was approved and it appearing to the Board that the law had been substantially complied with. It was ordered that H.N. Oliver, Silas D. Odder & P.G. Simons be appointed Viewers of the said road and that upon the day named in their notice together with the County Surveyor they proceed to view and lay out said road according to law giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to this Board.
