

In the matter of the Petition of
 Jas A. Davidson and others for the
 Location of a Road.

On the 1st day of October 1883, a road petition was filed and presented to the Board of Co. Commrs, signed by Jas A Davidson and 17 others praying for the location of a County Road described as follows: Beginning on road running N. to the Kaw River 40 R W of NE. of Sec 31, 11, 18. at stake known as NW cor of land sold to W. Brown out of said Sec 31, 11, 18. thence due West $62\frac{1}{4}$ Sec lines until it strikes road petitioned for by P. K. Gellau which runs due N. through Sec. 36, 11, 17. Said petition was accompanied with bond as required by law signed by Jas A Davidson as principal and J. F. Masterson as surety in the sum of all costs and expenses which bond was approved and it appearing to the Board that the law had been substantially complied with it was ordered that R. Richards, J. Cunningham and J. C. Vincent be appointed Viewers of the said Road and that upon the day named in their notice together with the County Surveyor they proceed to view and lay out said road according to law giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to this Board.
