{ On the 9th day of October 1883, a road petition was filed and presented to the Board of Co Comrs. signed by W. H. Armstrong and 13. others praying for the location of a County Road as follows: Begin at N.E. Cor of N. W. 1/4 Sec. 7, 13, 20. thence S. along 1/2 Sec. line until it strikes N. line Sec. 19, 13, 20. at N.E. cor of N. W. 1/4 said Sec. 19. Said petition was accompanied with Bond as required by law signed by W. H. Armstrong as principal and W. B. Kennedy as surety in the sum of all costs and expenses, which bond was approved and it appearing to the Board that the law had been substantially complied with It was ordered that Jordan Neal, J. J. Mc Kee and George Cady be appointed Viewers of the said road and that upon the day named in their notice together with the County Surveyor they proceed to view and lay out said road according to law giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to this Board.
