

In the matter of the Petition of James Tally and others for the location of a Road. { The Board of County Commissioners having under consideration the aforesaid Road and no legal objections having been offered against the establishment of the same and believing it to be of public utility it was ordered that the various report and views and report and plan of survey be adopted and the said road be declared located and established in accordance therewith (except the 3^d & 4th mile) full record thereof to be made in the County road record and the Trustee of Marion Township be notified to cause the same to be opened for the public travel. It was further ordered that the County Clerk be instructed to issue County scrip in favor of J.W. Ray for \$70⁰⁰ in full compensation for all damages occasioned by the location and establishment of said road.
