Board of County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment at the office of the County Clerk.

There were present Comrs J. C. Walton Chairman, John Walton and P. A. Dobbs and County Clerk H. O. Towns.

Appropriation for Bridges {
in Clinton Township. { It was ordered That an appropriation of \$600⁰⁰ each be made to assist Clinton Township in building two bridges over Rock Creek, one at Anderson crossing and one at either Stude or Davis Crossing as the Board may hereafter determine. It is the understanding that the above appropriation is to be used from the first available monies in the County Bridge Fund.

J. J. Bell Road {
Damage Allowed { The Board ordered That \$110⁰⁰ be issued in County scrip to Hays & Pettengill as damages in full on account of compromise on appeal to District Court of Road Case of J. J. Bell and others.

Bond Compromise {
The Board ordered That an appropriation of \$262¹² be made, payable from the County Insurance Fund, to pay balance due G. W. Cuffelt on Bond settlement of Dec. 5th 1883.

Bridge Appropriation {
Lawrence Bridge { The Board ordered That an appropriation of \$4950⁰⁰ be made to complete payment for Lawrence Bridge and for raising span and building piers higher for same. The Chairman of the Board and the County Clerk are authorized to issue scrip on this appropriation upon acceptance of the work by the Board.
