Board of County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment, at the office of the County Clerk

There were present Commissioners J. C. Waller Chairman John Waller and Mr. Brager and County Clerk Joel Smith.

Proposition of

J. E. Griffith. The Board having under consideration the aforesaid proposition it was ordered, that the County Treasurer be authorized to permit J. E. Griffith to redeem the County interest by reason of Tax Sale of 1866 for Tax of 1865 in lot 52 Vermont Street for amount of original sale without cost of redemption. It was further ordered that J. E. Griffith be permitted to redeem by reason of Tax Sale to the County, Sale of 1866 for 1865, lot 143 Kentucky Street for his Brother J. E. Griffith for amount of original sale without cost of redemption.

The Board had under consideration Road Petitions and Claims against the County.

Board adjourned to meet April 9th at 9 o'clock.
