Board of County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment in the office of the County Clerk.

There were present Commissioners J. C. Matten, Sebastian, John Matten and H. D. Drafes and County Clerk J. S. White

In the Matter of Petition of }
Emanuel Hill & 13 others }
to locate Road. }

On the 7th of April, 1884 a Petition was filed signed by Emanuel Hill and 13 others praying for a Road to be located as follows: Beginning in the Centre of Walnut Street extended East from North Lawrence thence running South on the East Boundary of North Lawrence 40 Rods to the Centre of Oak Street extended East from the said North Lawrence in the South East $\frac{1}{4}$ of the South West $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 29, T. 12, R. 20, in Douglas County Kansas.

The Board having under consideration the aforesaid Road and no legal objections having been made against the establishment of the same and believing it to be of public utility. It was ordered that said Road be declared located and established and full record thereof be made in the Road Record. It was further ordered that the County Clerk be instructed to issue County Scrip in favor of S. J. Sen Hardin for the land dedicated to said road. Seventy five Dollars (\$75.00) the land indicated being thirty (30) feet wide off of the west side of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 29, T. 12, R. 20.
