C. Mallett } The Board Having under consideration the aforesaid proposition
it was ordered that the County Treasurer execute and the County Clerk
assign to C. Mallett the County interest by reason of Tax Sales, Certificate
Sales of 1877, 1878, 1879, 1880, 1881, 1882, 1883, in the Strip of land 45 by 75 feet in
Block 4 East add. to City of Lawrence for twenty five dollars, without
cost of transfer.

Proposition of }
J. G. Schmebly } The Board Having under consideration the aforesaid proposition
it was ordered that the County Treasurer be authorized to execute and the County
Clerk to assign to J. G. Schmebly the County interest by reason of Tax Sales in
lots 76 & 77 King Street Baldwin City for amount of original sale.

Proposition of }
Charles Wendenhall } The Board Having under consideration the aforesaid proposition
it was ordered that the County Treasurer be authorized to execute and the County
Clerk assign to Charles Wendenhall the County interest by reason of Tax Sales in
1/4 of an acre in n/4 of 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30, 31, 32 without cost of transfer.

Proposition of }
H. Whitney } The Board Having under consideration the aforesaid proposition
after careful examination find that the Tax Sales to the County, in the years
1862, 1863, 1864 & 1867, in A. N. P. Sec. 5 & 24, R. 21, were illegal, being at the time
Indian land and not subject to taxation. It was ordered by the Board
that the County Treasurer be authorized to Cancel Certificate covering these
sales to wit # 926, 721, 610, & 499.
