

Shawnee News. April 12, 1884.

Board of County Comm. met pursuant to adjournment at the office of the County Clerk.

There were present Commissioners J. Corralles, Chairman, John Maltin and Mr. Draper and County Clerk Joel S. White.

In the Matter of Petition
of Ole Simonsen & Others
for location of Road

On the 15th day of March 1884 a road petition was filed signed by Ole Simonsen and 15 others and presented to the Board of Commissioners praying for the location of a County road described as follows: "Beginning at the quarter section corner on the west line of section 35, T. 13, R. 17, and run thence South on west line of said Sec. 35 wide to the South west corner thereof." said petition was accompanied with Bond as required by law signed by Ole Simonsen as principal and H. S. White & C. Olsen as sureties in the sum of one hundred dollars, which bond was approved and it appearing to the Board that the Law had been substantially complied with it was ordered that J. A. Haldermann, J. B. Patefish and J. R. Woodard be appointed viewers of said road and that upon the day named in their notices together with the County Surveyor they proceed to view and lay out said Road, in conjunction with viewers from Shawnee County, according to law going to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to this Board.

In the Matter of Petition of
F. D. Keowl & 18 others
for location of Road

On the 1st day of April 1884 a Road petition was filed signed by F. D. Keowl and 18 others and presented to the Board of Commissioners praying for the location of a County road described as follows: "Beginning at the S.W. corner of section 3, T. 13, R. 17, where the Shawnee and Sapulpa road leaves the County line between the Counties of Shawnee & Douglas Counties and thence north along said County line (or as near thereto as a practicable road can be made) to intersect a road as now laid out from Glendale Douglas County to Sapulpa. Distance from place of beginning about one and a half miles." said petition was accompanied with Bond as required by law signed by F. D. Keowl as principal and F. S. Bell as surety in the sum of all costs and expenses accruing on the road, which bond was approved and it appearing to the Board that the Law had been substantially complied with, it was ordered that J. G. Jones, M. L. Minter & M. C. Porter be appointed viewers of said road and that upon the day named in their notices together with the County Surveyor and in conjunction with viewers from Shawnee County, they proceed to view and lay out said Road, according to law going to all parties a hearing, and make due report of their proceedings to this Board.
