

In the Matter of Petition
of A. L. Wood & 13 others.
For a Public Private road

On the 1st day of April AD 1884 a road petition was filed signed by A. L. Wood and 13 others and presented to the Board of Commissioners for the location of a Public Private road described as follows.

"Beginning at a point at the N.W. Corner of the East Half of the N.E. 1/4 of Sec. 17, 13, 19, belonging to Mr. Engler, and on petition that the said road shall be 20 feet wide running South from place of beginning 160 rods to Chas. Longfellow's line 40 rods of said road to be taken off of the East end of John A. Coleman's land and the remaining 120 rods to occupy land set off for road East of the lands belonging to A. L. Wood Samuel J. Boyant and J. A. Riddling. Said petition was accompanied with Bond as required by Law, signed by A. L. Wood as Principal and Samuel J. Boyant & J. A. Riddling as sureties in the sum of costs and expenses which ^{bond} was approved and it appearing to the Board that the law had been substantially complied with it was ordered that N. B. Kinsley, Andrew Douglas, Thasayette Reese be appointed viewers of said road and that upon the day named in their notice together with the County Surveyor they proceed to view and lay out said road according to law giving to all parties a hearing and ^{make} due report of proceedings to this Board.

In the Matter of Petition of
Daisy C. Hostetter & others.
to locate Road

On the 9th day of April AD 1884 a road petition was filed signed by D. C. Hostetter and 17 others and presented to the Board of Commissioners for the location of a Public road described as follows.

"Beginning at a point in Grant Township where the Range line between Ranges 19 & 20 crosses the County line between the Counties of Douglas and Jefferson thence running East on said County line to the corner of Sec. 6 and 5 in Douglas County and Sec. 31 & 32 in Jefferson County."

Said petition was accompanied with Bond as required by law signed by Daisy C. Hostetter as Principal and Thomasanna Blackman as surety in the sum of costs and expenses, which Bond was approved and it appearing to the Board that the law had been substantially complied with, it was ordered that Kylee Ross, Ed. Zimmerman & Sydney Herd be appointed viewers of the said road and that upon the day named in their notice together with the County Surveyor they proceed to view and lay out said road according to law giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to this Board.
