In the Matter of Petition
of C. M. Thompson for
location of Road }

On the 14th day of April 1884 a road petition was filed signed by C. M. Thompson and 20 others and presented to the Board County Comm. praying for the location of a road described as follows.

"Beginning at the Southwest corner of the North west quarter of Sec. 23. T. 13. R. 17. on the County line between Douglas and Shawnee Counties thence North on said line 2 1/2 miles to Highway running to Sapulpa."

Said petition was accompanied by Bond according to law, signed by C. M. Thompson as principal and Arthur Reichel as surety in the sum of \$500 and expense, which Bond was approved and it appearing to the Board, that the law had been substantially complied with it was ordered that J. C. Vincent & J. Jones & Henry be appointed viewers of said road and upon the day named in their notice together with the County Surveyor and in conjunction with viewers from Shawnee County, they proceed to view and lay out said road according to law, giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to this Board.
