Dedication of a
Road. P. A. Dalbey

The Board having under consideration the Dedication
of a Road by P. A. Dalbey. It was ordered that said Dedication be
accepted as follows. "Beginning at a point on the Lawrence and
Marion road 36 1/2 chains South and South west along said County road
from the N.E. Corner of Sec. 1. S. 2. T. 14. R. 18. Thence South 76° West 18 chains,
thence S. 60° W. 1 chain, thence S. 55° W. 3 1/2 chains, thence S. 45° W. 1 chain to
intersection with said County road all in Section 1. T. 14. R. 18."

In the Matter of
Petition of Chas. Cox et al.
for Location Road

This day a road petition was filed signed by Charles
Cox and 20 others, and presented to the Board of County Comrs. praying for
the location of a road described as follows.

"Beginning at the S.W. Corner of the S.E. 1/4 between Sections 2 and 11,
S. 13. R. 20, thence South about 3/4 mile to intersect County road in South
1/2 of Sec. 11. S. 13. R. 20. Said Petition was accompanied by Bond as required
by law, signed by Chas. Cox as principal and J. B. Barnham, Chas. W. Farland
and John Silmons as sureties in the sum of Cash and expenses, which Bond
was approved and it appearing to the Board that the law had been
substantially complied with. It was ordered that Jordan Seal,
Levi W. Pierce & M. Miller be appointed viewers of said road and
that upon the day named in their notice together with the County Surveyor
they proceed to view and lay out said road according to law giving
to all parties interested a hearing and make due report of their
proceedings to this Board."
