On this day a road petition was filed signed by Paul Coffey by his atty. O. M. Wilchum, praying for the location of a private road as follows. "Beginning on the South line of Sec. 2. in Township 13. Signed by Paul Coffey as principal and Henry Coffey as surety in the sum of Costs and Expenses, which Bond was approved and it appearing to the Board that the law had been substantially complied with. Leary be appointed viewers of said road and that upon the day of named in their notice together with the County Surveyor they proceed to view and lay out said road according to law giving to all parties a hearing and make report of their proceedings to this Board.
