Board of County Commissioners met in Special Session at the Office of the County Clerk.

There were present Commissioners J. C. Martin Chairman, John McClellan and Wm. Draper, and County Clerk Joel S. White

Proposition of
Lawrence Transportation Co.

for right of way across the
Bridge at Lawrence.

for the period of thirty years.

The Board having under consideration the aforesaid proposition it was granted upon the following conditions to wit.

First. The Lawrence Transportation Company shall lay a double track across said Lawrence Bridge.

Second. That the said Lawrence Transportation Company shall pay Eight Seventieths ($\frac{8}{70}$) of all the Expenses of maintaining the floor system on said Bridge.

Third. Said Lawrence Transportation Company shall lay ^{and maintain} a plank on the outside and along each rail of said tracks across said Bridge to be of such width and thickness as the County Board of Commissioners may direct.

Fourth. The location of said Street Car Tracks across said Bridge to be determined by the Board of County Commissioners.

Fifth. The Board of County Commissioners reserve the right to stop the running of said Street Cars across said Bridge at any time when necessary to make repairs on said Bridge.

Sixth. The payments above mentioned shall be made at the end of each and every quarter which expense shall be fixed and determined by the Street Commissioners of Lawrence at ~~such~~ such estimates are made.

Seventh. The above license shall be of no effect until the same shall have been accepted by said Lawrence Transportation Company and the same shall be accepted before any work is done on said Bridge, otherwise this grant shall be null & void.

Eighth. The form of such acceptance referred to above, shall be approved by the County Attorney. We accept the above conditions from this 4th

day of Aug 1884
