Dedication of the
James H. Woodward Road }

The Board having under consideration the Dedication of a Road by J. S. Steele. It was ordered that the Dedication be accepted as follows. Beginning about 8th Ch. S. of the 4th Sec. Corner between Sec. 24 & 13 R. 17. And Sec. 19 & 13 R. 18. (the S. E. Corner of S. 29 & Sec. 24 & 13 R. 17) thence Easterly to the top of Bluff. Thence West about 2nd Ch. to Sec. line. It was further ordered that the County Clerk be instructed to issue County scrip to J. S. Steele for twenty dollars in full compensation for all damages occasioned by the location and establishment of said road.

Dedication of the
James H. Woodward Road }

The Board having under consideration the Dedication of a Road by R. A. & Blake. It was ordered that the Dedication be accepted as follows. Beginning 14th Ch. East of the S. W. corner of the S. W. 1/4 of Sec. 22 & 13 R. 17. Thence S. 73rd E. 2nd Ch. thence S. 71st E. 2nd Ch. to County road again.
