A. & S. R. R. and the right to build thereon such buildings, wharves and
approaches as he may find necessary in the prosecution of his said
business, and the right to hold said land until notified by the County
Board to vacate the same and that he may have sixty days time
after such notice to remove the buildings and improvements he may
put on said land.
