The Board of County Commrs. met pursuant to adjournment in the office of the County Clerk.

There were present Commrs. J. C. Walton Chairman, John Walton and Mr. Draper and County Clerk Joel S. White.

In the Matter of Petition
of Chas. Cox and others
for the Location of a Road. }

The Board having under consideration the aforesaid Road and no legal objections having been made against the establishment of the same and believing it to be of public utility it was ordered that the surveyors report and view and report and plat of survey be adopted and the said Road be located and established in accordance therewith full record thereof to be made in the County Road Record and the Trustees of Eudora Township be notified to cause the same to be opened for the public travel. It was further ordered that the County Clerk be instructed to issue County Scrip in favor of Frank L. Nichols for \$30.00 Fred. E. Copp for \$10.00 John Simas for \$10.00 J. B. Pambam for \$50.00 Chas. Cox for \$25.00 in full compensation for all damages occasioned by the Location and Establishment of said Road.

The Board had under consideration the vacation of certain lots - streets and alleys in the City of Eudora and after an able discussion of the matter by a delegation of citizens of said City it was postponed until Monday July 14.

The Board had under consideration claims against the County.
