

In the Matter of the Petition of }
 Franz Vogle and others, }
 to change location of }
 County Road }

On the 25th day of June A.D. 1884 a road petition was filed and presented to the Board of County Commrs. signed by Franz Vogle and 26 others praying to change and relocate the County road running through the South half of Sec. 34, S. 13, R. 21, as follows.

Vocate. That portion of said road as now laid on the said South half of said Sec. 34 and Locate as follows.

Beginning at the North West Corner of the North East quarter of the South East quarter of said Section 34, S. 13, R. 21. thence South 80 rods to the center of said S.E. 1/4, Sec. 34. thence West 80 rods to the 4th section line. thence South on said line about 35 rods. thence about 60 rods in a southeasterly direction around a bluff to the section line on the South about 30 rods West of the South East corner of the S.W. 1/4 of said Sec. 34. thence West on said Sec. line about 100 rods. thence about 30 rods in a southeasterly direction around a bluff in the North West corner of the 4th 1/4 of Sec. 3. S. 13, R. 21. to intersect a point in the section line road about 30 rods South of the said North West corner of S.W. 1/4, said Sec. 3.

Said petition was accompanied by Bond as required by law signed by Franz Vogle as principal and Herman Stadler and John L. Brander as surety in the sum of all costs and expenses, which Bond was approved and it appearing to the Board that the law had been substantially complied with it was ordered, that Thomas Rayson, H. J. Kennedy, and J. J. Ireland be appointed viewers of the said road and that upon the day named in their notice together with the County Surveyor they proceed to view and lay out said road according to law giving all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to this Board.

for the location of a Road } The Board having under consideration the proposed Road and no legal objections having been made against the establishment of the same and believing it to be of public utility it was ordered that the viewers report and view and report and plat of survey be adopted and the said Road be located and established in accordance therewith full record thereof to be made in the County Road Record and the Director of Aurora Township be requested to cause the same to be opened for the Public Travel.

Adjourned to meet July 1st, 1884.
