The Board of County Comrs. met pursuant to adjournment at the office of the County Clerk.

Here were present Commissioners J. E. Waller Chairman, John Martin and Geo. Draper and County Clerk J. S. White.

In the Matter of the Petition of
J. A. Hartig and others for the
vacation of certain streets and
alleys in Eudora City

The further hearing of the above matter coming on this day in accordance with the order of this Board made August 6, 1880, and the said matter having been continued to day and fully considered, it is hereby ordered that the prayer of the said petition for the vacation of streets and alleys in Eudora City, aforesaid be and the same is hereby denied.

In the Matter of Petition of
H. A. Henkle for Bridge
across Captains Creek, Eudora Twp.

The Board having under consideration the aforesaid Petition it was ordered that John Martin be and is hereby appointed a Committee to visit the place of proposed location of said bridge - examine the same and make report to this Board.

In the Matter of the Petition of
Emmanuel Hill and 13 others

For the Location of Road } on the 7th day of April 1884 a road petition was
filed and presented to the Board of County Comrs. signed by Emmanuel Hill
and 13 others praying for the location of a road as follows. Beginning in the
center of Walnut Street extended East from North Laurens, thence running
~~South~~ on the East boundary of North Laurens 40 rods to the center of
Oak Street.
