

In the Matter of the Petition of  
D. C. Coatsworth and others }  
for the location of a Road }

The Board having under consideration the aforesaid Road and no legal objections having been made against the establishment of the same and believing it to be of public utility it was ordered, that the viewers report and view and report and plat of survey be adopted and the said Road be located and established in accordance therewith, full record thereof to be made in the County Road Record and the Surveyor of Grant Township be notified to cause the same to be opened for the public travel.

It was further ordered that the County Clerk be instructed to issue County Scrips in favor of James H. Barrow for \$70<sup>00</sup> in full compensation for all damages occasioned by the location of and Establishment of said Road.

In the Matter of Petition of  
D. H. Bailey and others for  
location & vacation of Road }

On the 7<sup>th</sup> of July A.D. 1884 a road petition was filed and presented to the Board of County Com. signed by D. H. Bailey and 41 others praying for the location and vacation of a Road as follows. Locate- Beginning at the RR crossing about 10 rods north of the 44 section corner between Sec. 10<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> Township 13 Range 18 being the N.W. corner of T. 24 of Sec. 15. S. 13. R. 18. thence South and South East on the most practicable route to intersect the Main County road leading to the town of Clinton about one mile in the North East of Sec. 22. Vacate- that part now running through the N.E. 1/4 of Sec. 15. S. 13. R. 18. being road No 223 and a part of the old road connected therewith all in the T. 24 of said Sec. 15.

Said petition was accompanied by Bond as required by Law signed by D. H. Bailey as principal and C. H. Hicks as surety in the sum of all costs and expenses, which Bond was approved and it appearing to the Board that the Law had been substantially complied with. it was ordered that W. S. Minter, J. D. Patches and R. J. Richards be appointed Viewers of the said Road and that upon the day named in their notice together with the County Surveyor they proceed to view and lay out said road according to law, giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to this Board.
