

Dedication of Road }

The Board having under consideration the Dedication of a Road by James W. Malbert J. A. Darnold, Agent Cause No. 7 Yorkmberger. It was ordered that the Dedication be accepted, as follows. Locate, Beginning 1 chain South of the S. W. Corner of S. E. 1/4 of Sec. 6, T. 14, R. 19, thence S. 49° E. 2 Ch. S. 9° E. 3 Ch. S. 6 1/2° E. 1 1/4 Ch. S. 5 1/2° E. 3 1/2 Ch. S. 12° N. 3 1/4 Ch. S. 40° N. 4 Ch. to intersect road again, also Beginning at a point in 1/2 Section line 4 Ch. S. of S. E. Corner of S. E. 1/4 of S. W. 1/4 of Section 11, T. 14, R. 19, thence S. 25° N. 1 5/8 Ch. S. 12 3/4° N. 6 7/10 Ch. S. 9° N. 1 8/10 Ch. S. 25° N. 2 3/10 Ch. S. 11° N. 2 2/10 Ch. S. 21 1/2° E. 3 2/10 Ch. S. 31 1/2° E. 2 2/10 Ch. S. 20° E. 1 2/10 Ch. S. 32° E. 1 2/10 Ch. to 1/4 Sec. line in County road. It was further ordered that the County Clerk be instructed to issue County Scrip in favor of James W. Malbert for twenty dollars (\$20.00) in full compensation for all damages occasioned by the location of said Road.

In the Matter of the Petition }
 of George Zieb and others }
 for a Road }

On the 12 day of June A.D. 1884 a road petition was filed signed by George Zieb and 26 others and presented to the Board of Com. praying for the Location and location of a Road described as follows. Locate, Beginning at the S. W. Corner of S. W. 1/4 of Sec. 22, T. 12, R. 18, thence East and South East on the most practicable route to intersect the State road again on the East line of said 1/4 sec. Vacate, old road between said points. Said petition was accompanied by bond as required by law, signed by George Zieb as principal and A. H. Beck as surety in the sum of \$500.00 costs and expenses, which Bond was approved and it appearing to the Board that the law had been substantially complied with, it was ordered that Saml. Raber, O. P. Kennedy and Eli Wilson be appointed viewers of said Road and upon the day named in their notice together with the County Surveyor they proceed to view and lay out said road according to law giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to this Board.
