Petition of Read }
Ole Anderson & others }

On the 19th of March 1884, a Road petition was filed and presented
to the Board of County Commrs. signed by Ole Anderson and 16 others praying for
the location of a County line Road as follows.

Beginning at the quarter section corner on the west line of Section 35 Township
13 Range 17, and run thence South on the west line of said Section one half mile to
the south west corner thereof. Said petition was accompanied with Bond
as required by Law signed by Ole Anderson as principal and A. S. White and
C. Peters as sureties in the sum of all costs and expenses, which bond
was approved and it appearing to the Board that the Law had been
substantially complied with it was ordered that J. A. Hardeman & Joseph
J. Woodward be appointed viewers.

The Board having under consideration the aforesaid road and no legal
objections having been made against the establishment of the same
and believing it to be of public utility it was ordered that
the viewers report and view and report and plat of survey be
adopted and the said Road be located and established in
accordance therewith, full record thereof to be made in the County Road
Record and the Master of the Public Works, and the County Clerk of Lawrence
Ks. be notified to cause the same to be opened for the public travel.
