

Lancaster Mass. Oct. 10, 1884.

Board of County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment at the office of the County Clerk, there were present Com. J. H. Norton Chairman, John Norton and W. D. Rapier and County Clerk Joel S. White.

In the Matter of the petition of
Frank Regis and others for the
location of a road

The Board having under consideration the aforesaid road and no legal objection having been offered against the establishment of that part which is hereby granted, and believing it to be of public utility it was ordered. That, 'Commencing at the place of beginning as called for in said petition, a road be and the same is hereby located & established Eighty rods in length. Thence from said place of beginning to with the N. W. corner of the N. E. 1/4 of the S. E. 1/4, Sec. 34. 12. 21.

It was further ordered that full record be made in the County Road Record and the Trustee of Andover Corp. be notified to cause the same to be opened for the public travel. It was further ordered that the County Clerk be instructed to issue County Certificates of Location, Docket for County Tax, and no just compensation for all damages occasioned by the location of said road. Report of Trustee of
Andover Corp. }

The Trustee of Andover Corp. made verbal report of condition of water pools and urged the necessity of abating the same to prevent sickness. He was referred to the County Attorney for final instructions in regard to the matter.

The Board had under consideration claims against the County.
