

In the Matter of the Petition
of J. H. Ward & others }

On the 7th day of October A.D. 1884, a Road Petition was filed and presented to the Board of County Commissioners signed by J. H. Ward and 13 others praying for a County Road as follows:

"Commencing at the South West Corner of Sec. 33, in Township 11, South of Range 15, East and running thence North on the line between Sections 32 and 33, to a point about 40 rods South of the N.W. Cor. of said Sec. 33, thence North East to a point about 40 rods East of N.W. Cor. of said Sec. 33 and thence East and ending at the North East Cor. of the West 1/2 of N.W. 1/4 of said Sec. 33, S. 11, T. 11, R. 15, E." Said Petition was accompanied with Bond as required by Law, signed by J. H. Ward as principal and J. L. Masterson as security in the sum of all costs and expenses, which Bond was approved and it appearing to the Board that the Law had been substantially complied with it was ordered that J. L. Jones, Jacob Dildinger and D. O. Benjamin be appointed viewers of said Road and upon the day named in their notice together with the County Surveyor they proceed to view and lay out said road according to Law, giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to this Board.

In the Matter of the Petition
of James R. Kelley & others }

On the 30th day of August A.D. 1884 a Road Petition was filed and presented to the Board of County Commrs. signed by James R. Kelley and 41 others praying for a County Road as follows. - Vacate.

"Beginning at a point 29 chains North of the 1/4 Corner between Sec. 20, 21, 22, 19, thence S. 89 1/2° E. 28 chains, thence North 55 1/4° E. 20 7/10 chains to a point 15 1/2 ch. East of the 1/4 Cor. between Sec. 16, 21, 22, 19, locate. Commencing at the N.W. Cor. of said Sec. 21, S. 19, R. 19, in said County. Thence East along the line of said Section 21, 15 1/2 chains to the intersection of the Road already located along the North line of said Sec. 21." Said Petition was accompanied by a cash deposit with the County Treas. of twenty five dollars for costs and expenses in line of a Bond, which was approved, and it appearing to the Board that the Law had been substantially complied with, it was ordered that H. C. Conzies, Amos Douglas, M. A. Walker, be appointed viewers of said Road and upon the day named in their notice together with the County Surveyor they proceed to view and lay out said Road according to Law, giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to this Board.
