

Lawrence Kas Jan'y 8 1885

The Board of County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment  
in the office of the County Clerk.

There were present, <sup>come</sup> J. Walton, Chairman, John Walton  
and Mr Draper was County Clerk. Joel White

In the matter of the Petition  
of J. W. Preston and others for  
the Location of a Road.

On the 8<sup>th</sup> day of January 1885  
a Road petition was filed and presented to the Board of County  
Commissioners signed by J. W. Preston and 28 others praying for a  
Road, as follows.

Beginning at the SW. cor. of S.E. 1/4 of Sec 11. T. 15. R. 18 thence N. on  
1/2 Sec line to the NW. cor. of N.E. 1/4 of Sec 2. T. 15. R. 18 length 2 miles, of road,

Upon due consideration, no legal objections having been offered  
against the establishment of said road, and believing the same to be  
of public utility, it is Ordered: that the Viewers report of view,  
and report and plat of survey be adopted, and that said road  
be declared located and established as a public highway in  
accordance therewith; full record thereof to be made in the County  
Road Record and Plat, as Road No. 413; and the Trustee  
of Marion Township be notified to cause the same to be opened for the  
public travel.

It is further Ordered. That warrants be issued to the following named  
persons H. C. Fisher \$20.00, M. G. Sowers \$20.00 in full compensation for  
all damages occasioned by the location and establishment of said road.

In the matter of the Petition  
of N. E. Wood and others for Road

On the 11 day of April A.D. 1884, a Road petition was filed  
and presented to the Board of County Comm<sup>r</sup> signed by N. E. Wood and 13 others praying for a  
public private Road - as follows. 15 feet off the East side of the S.E. 1/4 of Ch. 8 1/4. Sec 12,  
18. 19. and 20 feet wide off the E. side of the S.W. 1/4 of the S.E. 1/4. 12. 13. 19. & the S.E. 1/4 of Ch. 8 1/4 of S.E. 1/4.

Upon due consideration, no legal objections having been offered against the establishment  
of said road, and believing the same to be of public utility, it is Ordered that the Viewers report of  
<sup>to the S.E. 1/4 of Ch. 8 1/4. Sec 12.</sup>  
view, as above recorded and dedication by John N. Holman and report and plat of survey be adopted,  
and that said road be declared located and established as a public highway in accordance therewith;  
full record thereof to be made in the County Road Record and Plat, as Road No. 414; and the Trustee  
of Marion Township be notified to cause the same to be opened for the public travel. It is further Ordered,  
That \$25.00 be issued to John N. Holman \$25.00 in full compensation for all damages  
occasioned by the location and establishment of said road.
