

In the matter of the
 Petition of a Road
 Petition of H. B. McCarty

On this day January 10. AD 1885 a petition was filed signed by H. B. McCarty and 17 others and presented to the Board of County Commissioners praying for the vacation of a Road described as follows.

Beginning at the NW Corner of Section 14. Township 12. Range 18. Thence East on Section line about 80 rods. Thence South about 160 rods all in Desomption Township

Said petition was accompanied by bond as required by law. Signed by J. S. Miller & H. B. McCarty, in the sum of costs and expenses, which bond was approved and it appearing to the Board that the law had been substantially complied with it was ordered that J. S. Miller, Clerk of Court, James Sapping, be appointed Viewers of said Road and upon the day named in their return together with the County Surveyor they proceed to view and vacate said road according to law, giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to this Board.

Board had under consideration claims against the County.

The Board having under consideration the proposed road and no legal objections having been offered against the establishment of said road, and believing it to be of public utility, it was ordered, that the viewers report of view, and report and plat of survey be adopted, and that said road be declared located and established as a public highway in accordance therewith. Commencing at the place of beginning running thence North 3/4 of a mile, full record thereof to be made in the County Road Record and Plat as road No. 426 and the Clerk of Township be notified to cause the same to be opened for the public travel.

Board adjourned to meet Jan'y 14. 1885. at 9 o'clock AM.
