Location of a Road

Petition by Thomas M. Hall

On this, the 14th day of January AD 1885, a petition was filed signed by Thomas M. Hall and others and presented to the Board of County Commissioners praying for the location of a road described as follows:

Beginning at the S.W. Corner of the S.W. 1/4 of Section 12, T. 15, R. 19, Shreve Park on the 1/4 Section line in said Section 12, T. 15, R. 19, one half mile to the S.E. Corner of said S.W. 1/4 of Section 12, T. 15, R. 19.

Said petition was accompanied by bond as required by law signed by J. M. Stewart and H. Shookly in the sum of five hundred dollars, which bond was approved and it appearing to the Board that the law had been substantially complied with, it was ordered that J. A. Haldeman, William Green & M. M. Williams be appointed viewers of said Road, and upon the day named in their return together with the County Surveyor they proceed to view and locate said road according to law, giving to all persons a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to this Board.
