

Baroness Stans. Jan'y 21, 1885.

Board of County Commissioners met in Special Session
at the Office of the County Clerk

There were present Commissioners John Martin
Chairman, Mr. Draper and J. E. McCoy and County Clerk Joel S. White

Petition of
Geo. Baroness
asking to be discharged
from imprisonment as a jail

On the 1st day of January A.D. 1885 a petition
signed by many of the Citizens of Baroness, was filed asking the Board
to discharge said Baroness from imprisonment from jail and fine of \$500.
The Court Records in this case show, that on or about the 26 day of Decr.
A.D. 1883 said Baroness was convicted before SD Anderson a justice of the Peace of
said County, of the Crime of selling intoxicating liquor contrary to Law and
was fined Five Hundred dollars and costs. By a verbal agreement with said
Baroness that he would not engage again in this unlawful business, the
sentence of the Court was not enforced. That on the 9th day of January, 1885
said Baroness was committed to the County Jail of said County, for the non-payment
of said fine and costs. Said Baroness having said intoxicated liquor being a bar, subsequent to the agreement aforesaid. Mr. Baroness was represented by able attorneys -
and the County by its attorney R. A. Brewster.

After a patient hearing of the case for and against the request of Mr.
Baroness - it was ordered that the request of the petitioners be refused.
