Relative to the East half of lot No 18 Vermont Street City of Lawrence  
the County interest in taxes on which I some time ago took an assignment  
having first procured all outstanding tax claims in individual hands, I now  
propose as follows: The claims of H. S. Tolman and W. A. Tolman, who held taxes  
of the years 1871, 1872, 1873, 1874, 1875, 1876, on said property I took up and was held.  
Their tax deeds never having been placed of record. I have taken a Last Claim  
deed from them running to Douglas County as none of their instruments have  
been placed of record. I propose to turn over to the County Clerk all of said  
deeds, provided you will order the original tax sales to be cancelled as  
illegal sales by reason of prior sale as County and then I intend amending  
the assignment of the County interest which I shall and then cancelling all the  
sales on the record.
