Relative to the East half of lot No 18 Vermont Irish City of Haverham the County interest in taxes on which I some time ago took an assignment having first procured all outstanding tax claims in individual hands, I now propose as follows: The claims of Mr. S. Wilson and Mr. A. Feltman, who held taxes of the years 1871, 1872, 1873, 1874, 1875, 1876, on said property I took up and now hold. Their tax deeds never having been placed of record. I have taken a List Return deed from them running to Douglas County as none of these instruments have been placed of record. I propose to turn over to the County Clerk all of said deeds, provided you will order the original tax sales to be cancelled as illegal sales by reason of prior sale as County and then I intend surrendering the assignment of the County interest which I hold and then cancelling all the sales on the Record.
