

In the matter of the }
 Petition of Henry Dague }
 for location of a Road }

On the 2nd day of March AD 1888 a Petition was filed signed by Henry Dague and 22 others and presented to the Board of County Commissioners praying for the Survey, laying out and Establishment of a Road as follows:

Beginning at section Corner on South East Corner of Section 35, T. 14, R. 17, and S. 11, Co. of Sec. 36, T. 14, R. 17, and S. 11, Corner of Section 1, T. 15, R. 17 and S. 11, Co. Sec. 1, T. 15, R. 17, thence north one mile to Section Corner at N.E. Corner of Sec. 35, T. 14, R. 17, thence south to Sec. Cor. on County line between Douglas and Osage County at North West Corner of Section 35, T. 14, R. 17, and S. 11, Co. of Section 36, T. 14, R. 17 all in Douglas County State of Kansas.

Said Petition was accompanied by Bond as required by Law signed by Henry Dague as principal and Charles Miller and David Knight as sureties in the sum of all Costs and Expenses, which Bond was approved and it appearing to the Board that the Law had been substantially complied with it was ordered that Absalom M. Nigro, Albert H. Carr & S. A. Kaldorman be appointed viewers of said Road and upon the day named in their notice together with the County Surveyor they proceed to view and locate said Road according to Law giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to this Board.
